If you have never participated in this event, I hope this is the year you walk through Doors Open Ottawa. Thank you to everyone involved in making sure this annual event continues to be a success.

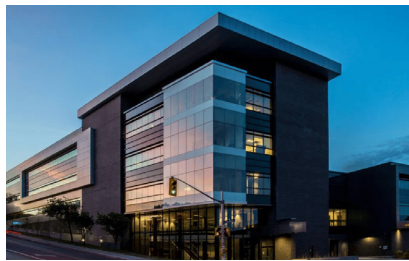
