

Andrew Cohen is a best-selling author, and award-winning journalist and former professor of journalism at Carleton University. In a career of 45 years, he has worked in Ottawa, Toronto, Washington, London and Berlin. Since 2002, he has written a weekly column on politics and culture for *The Ottawa Citizen*, syndicated in Postmedia Newspapers. He appears regularly in *The Globe and Mail*, *The National Post* and *The Toronto Star*, as well as writing for *Foreign Affairs*, *United Press International*, *Time*, *CNN.com*, *Maclean's*, *The Financial Times of London*, *The New York Times*, among others. He has won two National Newspaper Awards and three National Magazine Awards. His seven books include *While Canada Slept: How We Lost Our Place in the World*, a finalist for the Governor General's Literary Award for Non-Fiction, as well as *A Deal Undone: The Making and Breaking of the Meech Lake Accord*; *Trudeau's Shadow: The Life and Legacy of Pierre Elliot Trudeau*; *The Unfinished Canadian: The People We Are*; *Extraordinary Canadians: Lester B. Pearson*; and *Lost Beneath the Ice: The Story of HMS Investigator*. His latest book, *Two Days in June: John F. Kennedy's 48 Hours That Made History* was nominated for three literary awards. Andrew is the founding president of Historica Canada.
